

Connecting to the Campus Wireless Network (Windows Vista)

1. Right-click on the icon for **Wireless Connections** in the system tray in the lower right- hand corner of the desktop.
2. Click **Network and Sharing Center**
3. Click **Manage wireless networks** from the Task menu
4. Click **+Add**
5. Click **Manually create network profile**
6. Type **pirate** for Network Name, select **802.1x** for Security type, click **Next**

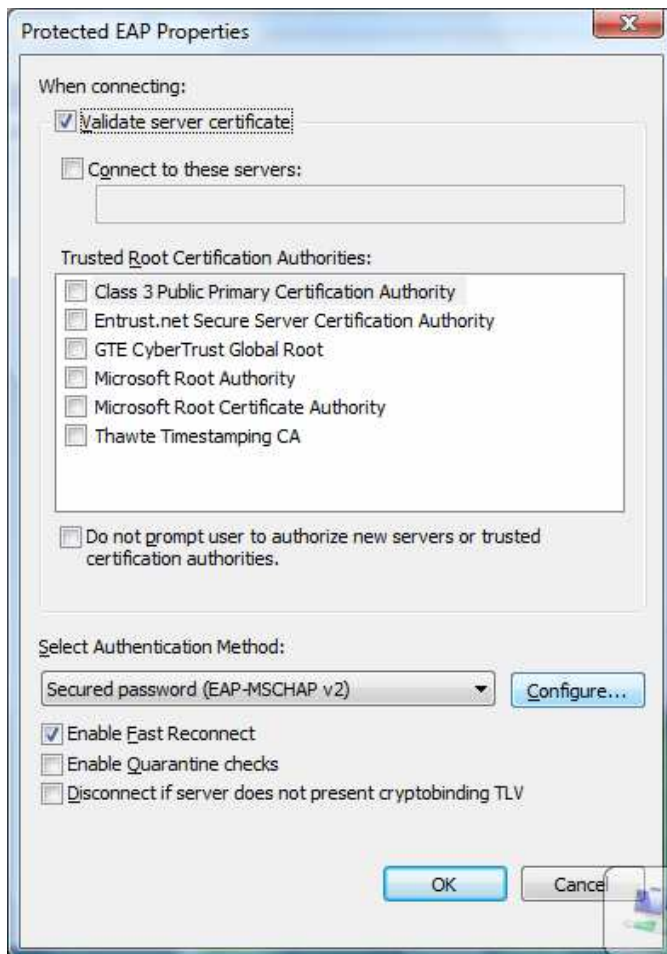

9. Click **Settings...**



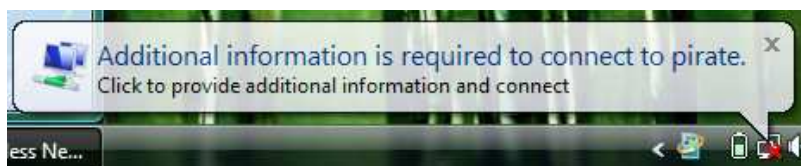
10. Click **Configure...**

11. Uncheck the box next to **Automatically use my windows logon name and password (and domain if any).**



12. Click **OK** button to this window, and each other property window that is open to close windows.

13. Once all the windows are closed, an alert will pop-up from the system tray in the lower right-hand corner. Click anywhere in this alert.



14. In the window that opens, enter your **university user id** in the User name field. Enter your **university password** in the Password field. Leave the Logon Domain blank. Click **OK**



15. Now you will wait while your computer establishes a connection to Pirate. Click the **Wireless Connection** alert pop-up from the system tray when it appears.

16. Once the validation is complete, simply click the **OK** button.



17. You are now connected.
