Who may apply for this scholarship?

The SU Excellence Scholarship has been established to recognize students who have excelled in their academic careers at Southwestern and who have not received a non need-based scholarship from Southwestern. To be a candidate for this scholarship a student must have completed at least one full-time semester at Southwestern, be currently attending Southwestern on a full-time basis, have minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0, and may not be the recipient of any other merit, talent, or non need-based scholarship or grant from Southwestern. As of April, 2010, this means that recipients of the following awards are ineligible for this scholarship:

Students who have previously received any of these awards but who have lost eligibility due to academic reasons are also ineligible to receive this scholarship.

This scholarship is competitive and is awarded on the basis of merit and not financial need. However, recipients who also receive need-based financial aid will have this scholarship incorporated into their need-based financial aid package. Candidates should note that meeting the minimum grade point requirement does not guarantee receipt of a scholarship.

If I meet the criteria above, does this mean I will receive the scholarship?

No. This is a competitive scholarship and the recipients will be selected from the pool of applicants for the scholarship. We anticipate that the pool of applicants will exceed the number of available scholarships. Therefore, not all applicants will receive the scholarship.

What is the amount of the scholarship and how many are available?

SU Excellence Scholarships are awarded in the amount of \$2,000 per year, to be disbursed at the rate of \$1,000 per semester. There are up to 10 scholarships awarded each year.

What is the duration of the scholarship?

SU Excellence Scholarships are awarded annually and are good for one year. The scholarship must be used during the regular academic year. The scholarship may not be used for summer school or for any type of program where SU funds may not be used, such as non-SU study abroad programs or the GLCA New York Semester.

Is the scholarship renewable?

The SU Excellence Scholarship is awarded for one year only and is not renewable. However, previous recipients may re-apply each year to be considered along with all other applicants for that year.

How are the recipients selected?

Applications are solicited though campus-wide announcements. Scholarship candidates will identify themselves. Candidates complete a scholarship application, which is submitted to the Office of Student Financial Assistance by May 1, 2012. Applications are reviewed by a selection committee, which determines the recipients of the award. All applicants will be notified of their final status in writing by June 30, 2012.
