Turner Caldwell Scholarship Application

Instructions:

Please complete the attached application and submit it to the Financial Aid Office by May 15, 2012. So that the scholarship selection committee may have access to your SU transcript, be sure to sign your application before you submit it. You may answer questions using a separate sheet of paper if necessary.

Who may apply for these scholarships?

The Pre-Med Scholarship and Turner Caldwell Scholarship at Southwestern recognizes students who have excelled in their academic careers at Southwestern and who plan to pursue enrollment in medical school upon graduation from Southwestern.

Candidates for the Pre-Med Scholarship should be following a course of study at Southwestern in preparation for enrollment in medical school, with the intent to enroll in a medical school after graduation from Southwestern. Candidates must have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA in order to be considered. Students planning to pursue enrollment in dental school are ineligible for this scholarship.

Candidates for the Turner Caldwell Scholarship should be following a course of study at Southwestern in preparation for enrollment in medical school, with the intent to enroll in a medical school after graduation from Southwestern. Candidates must have at least a 3.7 cumulative GPA in order to be considered and must be entering their senior year at Southwestern. Students planning to pursue enrollment in dental school are ineligible for this scholarship.

These scholarships are competitive and are awarded on the basis of merit and not financial need. These scholarships may be awarded in addition to other merit, fine arts, or non need-based awards. Recipients who also receive need-based financial aid will have this scholarship incorporated into their need-based financial aid package. Candidates should note that meeting the minimum grade point requirement does not guarantee receipt of a scholarship.

If I meet the criteria above, does this mean I will receive the scholarship?

No. This is a competitive scholarship and the recipients will be selected from the pool of applicants for the scholarship. We anticipate that the pool of applicants will exceed the number of available scholarships. Therefore, not all applicants will receive the scholarship.

What are the amounts of the scholarships and how many are available?

Pre-Med Scholarships are awarded in variable amounts from \$1,000 to \$5,000. The number of scholarships awarded each year varies with the number of candidates and the availability of funds.

The Turner Caldwell Scholarship is awarded in an amount up to \$10,000. One scholarship is awarded each year.

What is the duration of the scholarship?

The Pre-Med and Turner Caldwell Scholarships are awarded annually and are good for one year. These scholarships must be used during the regular academic year and are evenly disbursed between each semester. These scholarships may not be used for summer school or for any type of program where SU funds may not be used, such as non-SU study abroad programs or the GLCA New York Semester.

Are the scholarships renewable?

The Pre-Med Scholarship is awarded for one year only and is not renewable. However, previous recipients may re-apply each year to be considered with all other applicants for that year.

The Turner Caldwell Scholarship is awarded for one year only and is not renewable.

How are the recipients selected?

Applications are solicited through campus-wide announcements. Scholarship candidates will identify themselves. Candidates complete a scholarship application, which is submitted to the Financial Aid Office by May 15, 2012. Applications are reviewed by a selection committee, which determines the recipients of the award. All applicants will be notified of their final status in writing by June 30, 2012.
