United Methodist Scholarship Application

This application is for the scholarships listed below

J. A. Knowles Memorial Scholarship – \$1,000 to \$5,000 for one year

Funds for this program are received through the General Board of Higher Education and Ministry (GBHEM). Applicants must be an active, full member of the United Methodist Church for at least one year prior to application. In addition, candidates must be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States, and enrolled as a full-time student at Southwestern. Selection is based on merit and not need. Requires a minimum gpa of 3.0 to be considered.

United Methodist Scholarship - \$1,000 to \$3,000 for one year

Funds for this program are received through the General Board of Higher Education and Ministry (GBHEM). Applicants must be an active, full member of the United Methodist Church for at least one year prior to application. In addition, applicants must be a full-time degree seeking student at Southwestern, and must be a citizen or permanent resident of the U.S., or a member of one of the Central Conferences of the United Methodist Church. Applicants must file a FAFSA for the 2012-13 year and demonstrate financial need. Requires a minimum gpa of 3.0 to be considered.

United Methodist Foundation Scholarship – Four \$1,000 awards to a First-Year, Sophomore, Junior and Senior

Funds for this program are provided through the United Methodist Higher Education Foundation (UMHEF). Applicants must be members of the United Methodist Church for at least one year, and be U.S. citizens or permanent residents enrolled in full-time degree programs. Applicants must file a FAFSA for the 2012-13 year and demonstrate financial need. Requires a minimum gpa of 3.0 to be considered.

Texas United Methodist College Association Scholarships – variable amounts, \$1,000 minimum, based on need

Funds for this program are provided by the Texas United Methodist College Association (TUMCA). Applicants must be members of the United Methodist Church for at least one year, with their home church being in Texas. Applicants must file a FAFSA for the 2012-2013 year and demonstrate financial need. Requires a minimum gpa of 2.5 to be considered.

Martin Esteban Aleman Scholarship – \$2,000 for one year

Funds for this program are provided by the Martin Esteban Aleman, Truan-Aleman Memorial Scholarship Endowment. Applicants must be members of one of the Texas Conferences of the United Methodist Church and have taken an active leadership role within their conference. Preference is given to students who have taken an active leadership role in the Rio Grande Conference.

How are the recipients selected and when are they notified?

Applications are solicited through campus-wide announcements. Scholarship candidates will identify themselves. Candidates complete and submit a scholarship application, along with supporting documentation, to the Office of Student Financial Assistance by May 1, 2012. Applications are reviewed by the Office of Student Financial Assistance, which determines the recipients of the award. All applicants will be notified of their final status in writing by June 30, 2012.

If I meet the criteria above, does this mean I will receive the scholarship?

No. These are competitive scholarships and the recipients will be selected from the pool of applicants for the scholarship. We anticipate that the pool of applicants will exceed the number of available scholarships. Therefore, we do not anticipate that all applicants will receive a scholarship.

How does this scholarship affect any other financial aid I receive?

Students who are awarded any of these scholarships and who also receive need-based financial aid will have this scholarship incorporated into their need-based financial aid package in accordance with federal and state regulations and university policy.
