Thus, you'll want to discuss the ways in which the program relates to what you're doing at SU, what you believe you'll gain from the experience, and what you see as the challenges and possibilities of spending an extended time in another culture. Please attach your essay to the completed application form.
3. A recommendation from one Southwestern University faculty. Please give the recommendation form to one faculty member and ask them to complete the form and return them to the Office of Intercultural Learning: International and Off-Campus Programs.
4. By signing the Authorizations For Release, a copy of your transcript and disciplinary record will be obtained by the Office of Intercultural Learning.
