- Selective and independent four-year undergraduate national liberal arts college
- First institution of higher learning in Texas, chartered by the Republic of Texas in 1840
- Two colleges: The Brown College of Arts and Sciences and The Sarofim School of Fine Arts
- 1,372 men and women
- Minority students make up 25% of student body.
- Over the past five years, 50% of entering students (on average) ranked in the top 10% of their high school classes (SAT average: 1224).
- Southwestern Career Services was ranked one of the U.S.' top seven career centers by the Princeton Review for 2008.
- The Cooperative Education and Internship Association has recognized three Southwestern students as National Intern of the Year winners over the past six years.
- Southwestern signed the College and University Presidents Climate Commitment and was the 2nd university in Texas to sign Talloires Declaration (formal commitment to sustainability in higher education). Two new campus buildings earned LEED certification.

The Students: Smart and versatile

Students can't hide in giant lecture halls here. They must participate in rigorous small group seminars and often engage in one-on-one research with faculty.

The nature of learning here is interdisciplinary and requires integrating diverse information. And if they're not busy enough with that, they take part in nearly 100 student organizations, study abroad, volunteerism and internships.



- Student/faculty ratio of 10:1, with an average class size of 14 students
- 100% of tenured or tenure-track faculty hold doctorate or highest degree in their respective fields.
- Collaborative research and publication with students is common.
- 27 majors and pre-professional programs in medicine, law, engineering, education and theology
- More than 50% of students study abroad or participate in off-campus programs (NY Arts Program, DC Semester, summer biology research, etc.).
- Civic engagement: 60%+ of students volunteer on campus or in the community – twice the rate of the national average.
- Internships: Nearly 65% of students complete internships (for academic credit or experience only).
- Athletics: 18 Division III Intercollegiate teams; 22 intramural sports; 80%+ of students participate in physical activity.
- Leadership: 90+ student organizations
- Paideia Program: Our signature student program comprises civic engagement, intercultural experiences, undergraduate research and creative works.
