

Camp Victory, Afghanistan A film by Carol Dysinger

Using nearly 300 hours of verité footage shot between 2005 and 2008, Camp Victory, Afghanistan, directed by Carol Dysinger, is the first film to examine the reality of building a functioning Afghan military --- but is also a story about friendship and the unlikely bonds that form in war.

Filmmaker Carol Dysinger will be on campus to introduce the documentary. The showing will be followed by a panel discussion featuring John Piedmont, a retired Lt. Col. in the U.S. Marine Corps, and Erik Peterson, a marine who is returning from Kabul in August.

This event is part of the month-long series September 11, 2001: Memories, Legacies and Aftermaths Ten Years later.
