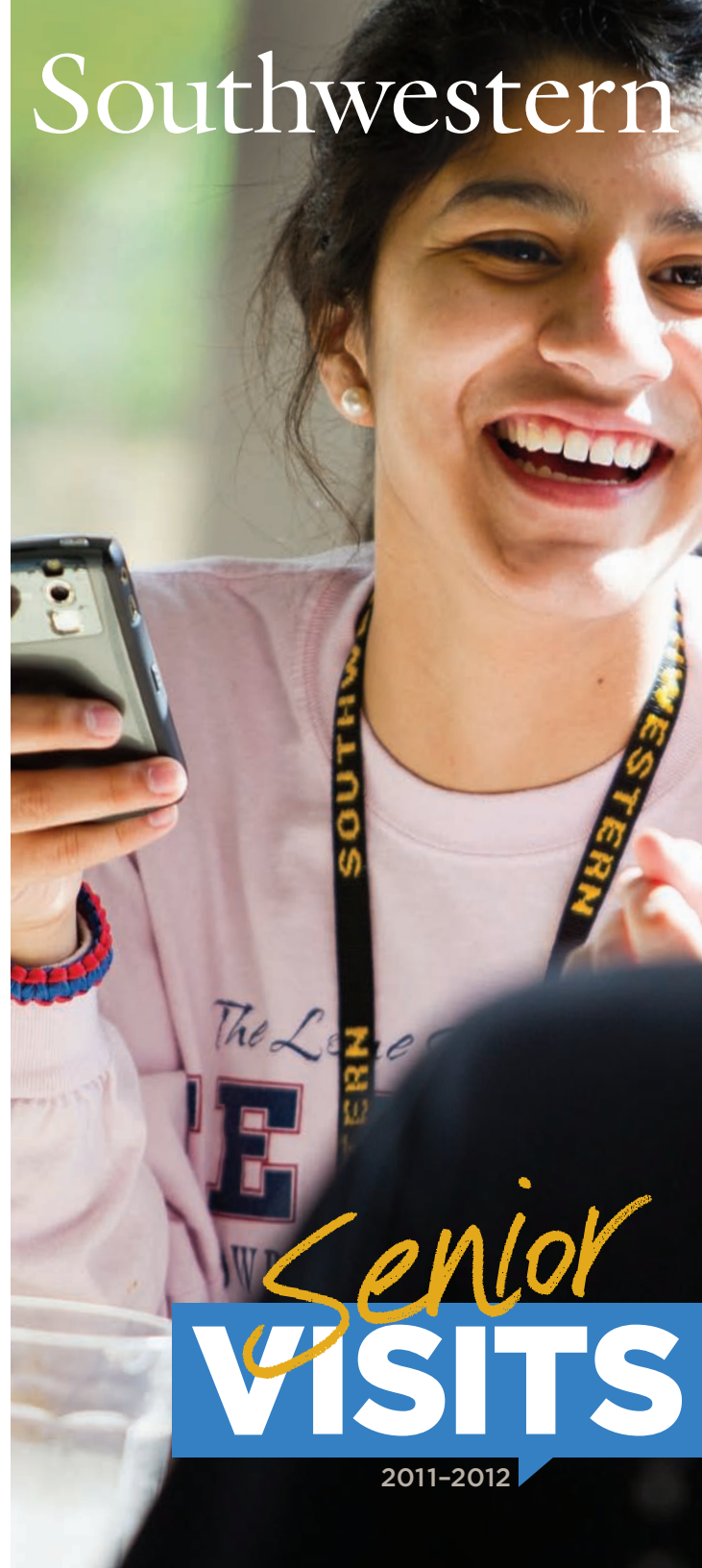

Want to know what COLLEGE is all about?

As **Colleges That Change Lives** and **Princeton Review** point out, there are plenty of perfectly rational reasons for choosing Southwestern University.

For instance, top-notch academics (*what your high school teacher meant when he said, 'Prepare.'*); a sense of history (*Texas' first university, established in 1840*); unconventional transportation options (*viva Pirate Bikes!*).

And then there's the intangible: what is life here really like? A college visit is a chance to test-drive Southwestern: you might attend a class, talk with current students, meet with a professor, coach or admission counselor, or even stay overnight in a residence hall.

Stay for a Bit

Standard Visits take about two hours and typically include a campus tour and a personal interview or information session.

Extended Day Visits take three to five hours, allowing for a tour and an interview as well as a class visit, an appointment with a faculty member or coach, and/or lunch.

Individual Overnight Stays are reserved for high school seniors, and include any or all of the above activities, plus an overnight stay in a residence hall, hosted by a current SU student. (Sunday–Thursday only.)

Saturday Visits include a campus tour, a Q&A with current students and a group information session. Saturday visits are available September–April.

Southwestern Showcase

Southwestern Showcase offers an introduction to Southwestern and the college search process. From 9 a.m. (*okay, so not exactly "College-Central Time"*) to 3 p.m., learn about:

- ▶ The college application process.
- ▶ Choosing a liberal arts and sciences education.
- ▶ The Sarofim School of Fine Arts.
- ▶ NCAA Division III athletics at Southwestern.
- ▶ What life on campus is like (*from current SU students*).
- ▶ How to finance a private education (*especially for the parental unit*).

Pirate Previews

Southwestern's Pirate Preview programs are scheduled in October, November and February.

Following a 9 a.m. check-in and grabbing a grandé from The Cove, you will have the opportunity to sit in on a variety of classes; tour campus; participate in panel presentations; meet your admission counselor; attend a luncheon (*arranged just for you*); connect with faculty and students; and even stay overnight on campus with a Southwestern student host the night before. (Please contact the Office of Admission to schedule an overnight option.)

Parents are invited and encouraged to attend various general information, admission and financial assistance panel presentations; a campus tour; and the luncheon. To maintain "cool parent" status, your student asks that you give them a little space to explore (*having your parents follow you around everywhere is sooo high school*).

Be sure to make a reservation at least two weeks prior to your visit. Depending on the number of responses, you may be placed on a waiting list.

You Plan the Trip, We'll Plan the Visit

The Office of Admission will make all of the arrangements for your visit. To make appointments for interviews, tours, individual overnight stays or group information sessions, simply call toll free (800-252-3166) or visit www.southwestern.edu. Please contact us two weeks prior to your arrival to allow adequate time to plan your visit. If you need special accommodations, please notify us at that time.

Permission to Come Aboard

To register for a Southwestern Showcase or a Pirate Preview, complete the appropriate reservation card. An e-mail with a detailed schedule will be sent as a reservation confirmation.

Keep in mind that the February Pirate Preview is reserved specifically for students who have already submitted an application for admission to Southwestern.
