## The One Band Show 2015 Chair responsibilities:

- Work directly with Student Activities professional staff on all aspects of planning The One Band Show.
- Attend weekly meetings with advisor (Rebecca), beginning the week of November 10<sup>th</sup> and continuing until two weeks after the concert (time to be determined based on Chair(s) schedules).
- Lead weekly meetings with The One Band Show Planning Committee. Meetings will be on Thursdays from 5:00-6:00 pm, beginning on November 13<sup>th</sup> and continuing until two weeks after the concert.
- Lead the Committee to research and identify potential bands.
- Assist Rebecca with the contracting process once the band is selected.
- Manage the budget.
- Ensure that Coordinators and Committee members stay on track towards their goals and responsibilities.
- Complete evaluations and wrap-up meetings following the concert.
- Additional responsibilities may vary based on interest and need, and alongside specific Coordinators, but could include the following: production and technical advancing (stage, lights, sound, backline, coordinating with band's production managers); hospitality and day-of logistics (coordinating with band's tour managers, catering, guest lists, greenroom, scheduling); promotions, publicity, and ticket sales (band announcement, marketing plans, promotional design, art direction for posters and ads); Committee and volunteer communication (day-of staffing, training, hospitality, disperse information throughout planning process); other duties as assigned
- Chair(s) should plan to commit approximately 5 hours minimum per week in the fall semester and 10 hours minimum per week in the spring semester (though hours will vary by week and will increase significantly as we get closer to the concert date). Chair(s) will have the opportunity to complete an internship for 4 hours of academic credit if they choose.

You will be notified by 4:00 pm on Wednesday, November 5<sup>th</sup> via email if you will be asked to schedule an interview. Interviews will be conducted if necessary on Thursday, November 6<sup>th</sup> or Friday, November 7<sup>th</sup>. The 2015 Chair(s) will be notified via email by 6:00 pm on Friday, November 7<sup>th</sup>.
