The plan has contracts with Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, Vision Service Plan, Hartford Life and Accident and Safeguard Health Plans, Inc., A Texas Corporation to pay Dental, Vision, Life Insurance, Long-term Disability and Accidental Death and Dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2014 were \$229,516.
