Recipients must meet all of the requirements for admission to Southwestern University and are required to maintain satisfactory academic progress (as defined by the University) in order to maintain eligibility. This award is only for full-time undergraduate study at Southwestern University. Recipients must be enrolled and degree-seeking at Southwestern University and may not have earned a bachelor's degree at Southwestern University or elsewhere. This award may not be used for summer school. Recipients may receive this award for a maximum of eight semesters.
