## Take a Test-Drive

As *Colleges That Change Lives* and *Princeton Review* point out, there are plenty of perfectly rational reasons for choosing Southwestern University: top-notch academics (*what your high school teacher meant when he said, 'Prepare.'*); a sense of history (*Texas' first university, established in 1840*); unconventional transportation options (*viva Pirate Bikes!*).

And then there's the intangible: what is life here really like? A college visit is a chance to test-drive Southwestern: you might attend a class, talk with current students, meet with a professor, coach or admission counselor, or even stay overnight in a residence hall.

## Stay for a Bit

*Standard Visits* take about two hours and typically include a campus tour and a personal interview or information session.

*Saturday Visits* include a tour and either an information session or interview. These sessions are available September–April and fill up quickly.

*Extended Day Visits* take three to five hours, allowing for a tour and an interview as well as a class visit, an appointment with a faculty member or coach, and/or lunch.

*Individual Overnight Stays* are reserved for high school seniors, include any or all of the above activities, plus an overnight stay in a residence hall, hosted by a current SU student. Available Sunday–Thursday.

## You Plan the Trip, We'll Plan the Visit

The Office of Admission will make all the arrangements for your visit to Southwestern. To make appointments for interviews, tours, individual overnight stays or group information sessions, simply call toll free: 800-252-3166. Please contact us at least two weeks prior to your visit to allow adequate time to plan your visit. If you need special accommodations, please notify us at that time.

# Senior Overnight Programs

Southwestern’s Senior Overnight Visits are scheduled in November and February.

Following a 5 p.m. check-in, you’ll have dinner with a student host, see a panel presentation and attend a social kick-off event. Stay overnight on campus with a Southwestern student host and after a good night’s sleep (or just a good night), grab a grande from The Cove and tour campus. Your day will also include: attending classes, meeting with your admission counselor and getting to know faculty members at a special luncheon arranged just for you.

Parents are invited to attend admission and financial assistance presentations the first night and are encouraged to participate in a parent panel, campus tours and luncheon the following day. To maintain “cool parent” status, your student asks that you find your own accommodations off campus (but nearby, of course).

# Registration

Be sure to make a reservation at least two weeks prior to your visit. Depending on the number of responses, you may be placed on a waiting list.

To register for Senior Visit Day or a Senior Overnight, complete the attached reservation card. An e-mail with a detailed schedule will be sent as a reservation confirmation.

Keep in mind that the February Overnight is reserved specifically for students who have already submitted an application for admission to Southwestern.
