- Under "Student/Learner", enter the registration code: **c0183011** to create your EverFi Account
- Complete Part 1 of both AlcoholEdu and Haven by August 22, 2016
- After 45 days you will receive an invitation to complete Part 2 of AlcoholEdu and Haven which must be completed by October 13, 2016.

- You will need Internet access and audio capabilities.

- You may take the course in multiple sittings.
- The course may include surveys to help personalize your experience and measure participants' attitudes and behaviors. All survey responses are confidential; the school will only receive information about the participant group as a whole and will never see individual answers.
