- (3) whose permanent home address is in one of the following counties (Bastrop, Blanco, Caldwell, Fayette, Hays, Lee, Llano, and Travis).

If I meet the criteria above, does this mean I will automatically receive the scholarship?

No. This is a competitive scholarship and the recipients will be selected from the pool of applicants for the scholarship.

How are the recipients selected?

Applications are solicited through announcements to the Southwestern Community. Scholarship candidates will identify themselves by completing a scholarship application, which must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office by May 1, 2018. Applications are reviewed by the Greater Austin Association committe. All applicants will be notified of their final status in writing by June 30, 2018.

What are the amounts of the scholarships and how many are available?

The number and amount of awards will be influenced by the number and quality of applications received. The Financial Aid Office will determine who will receive the scholarships, and in what amounts.
