A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 and a minimum of 127 credits are required to earn a degree at Southwestern. 64 credits must be completed in residence, including the last 32 credits. No more than 56 credit hours may be counted in one subject area. Graduation requirements within the major include a minimum of 30 credits, at least 60% must be upper-level, 60% taken in residence and 50% of courses taken at Southwestern, within the major, must be upper level. No grade below "C-" may be counted toward the major or minor. Minors require a minimum of 18 credits, 12 must be taken at Southwestern and 12 must be upper level. With the exception of FRAs and the FY/AES seminar, all gen.ed. requirements require a minimum of 3 credits, including Fine Arts Performance.
