



HATTON W. SUMNERS SCHOLARSHIP OF COMMUNITIES FOUNDATION OF TEXAS

Scholarship available for legal residents of TX, NM or OK who have completed 60 hours of college coursework, have four semesters remaining in college and intend to pursue a baccalaureate degree at any accredited college or university in TX, NM or OK.

Two-year scholarships are awarded in the amount of up to \$10,000 per year per student to deserving students based on the following eligibility requirements and selection criteria.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Legal resident of TX, NM or OK (for the past 12 months).
- Applicants must be in good standing at their college or university located in TX, NM or OK.
- 60 completed hours of college coursework.
- Four semesters remaining in college.
- Minimum 3.25 GPA.
- Recipients must agree to attend Public Policy Weekend OR Texas Tribune Festival AND any two other programs offered by the Hatton W. Sumners Foundation.

Selection Criteria:

Applicants will be reviewed based on two letters of recommendation, aspirations and ideals expressed in essay, school and extracurricular activities, and demonstrated leadership potential.

Finalists will be required to interview in person at Communities Foundation of Texas or via Skype with the scholarship committee during the month of May.
