Audience Policy, Goes into effect March 26, 2021

Southwestern University is pleased to announce it will begin allowing audiences, on a limited basis, to attend Sarofim School of Fine Arts Events. The following items must be followed to ensure a manageable performance experience:

- To ensure manageable performance experiences, performances and exhibitions are closed to all outside visitors except those listed on performance attendance lists.
- The adjusted Audience Policy only allows for the attendance of students, faculty, staff, and parents of students performing or on crew with limited exceptions.
- The parents are designated at the discretion of the studentperformer/crew, and may not be changed after the final list has been submitted to the Director of the Sarofim School of Fine Arts. Only audience members listed on the audience registration lists will be allowed to enter the facility.
 - RESERVATIONS WILL CLOSE THE WEDNESDAY BEFORE THE STARTING TIME OF THE PERFORMANCE.
- All audience members, regardless of vaccination of Covid-19, must wear a
 mask on Southwestern's campus both inside and outside buildings. Masks
 must be worn at all times. All masks must be a N95-style or surgical mask
 (i.e. bandanas, and gaiter masks are not acceptable). Mask must be worn
 over nose and mouth at all times.
- ALL attendees must practice 6' physical distancing.
- There will be no contact allowed between performers/crew and audience members.

- All audience members will be expected to exit the facility or open-air theater space upon conclusion of the event.
- Seating will begin 30 minutes prior to the start of the performance.
- Spectators will check with the house manager for the event where they will give the name they are listed under, show picture ID, and once confirmed, be shown to their seat.
- For outdoor Events: Please find a <u>map of Southwestern</u> and locations of Sarofim Outdoor Theater. Please park in parking lot East of the Tennis Courts located at #38 off of Southwestern Blvd. For the **Lois Perkins Chapel** #22 please park in the Fine Arts parking lot at #26.
- Please be aware you will be required to check-in once you arrive for concerts. It will be first come, first sat. All attendees will be sat at five minutes before the start of the concert. You will stand in a line outside the audience space until that point.
